



Ronny Depoortere succeeds Pierre Lambert as CEO of Zetes, a Panasonic Group company

Tokyo, 21 January 2026 – Pierre Lambert, the current CEO of Zetes, has decided to step down from his role. On the 1st April 2026, he will hand over the torch to Ronny Depoortere, the founder and current President of People ID.

In 2017, Zetes, a Belgian company specialising in supply chain and identity solutions, became a wholly owned subsidiary of Panasonic Corporation and has been delighted so far with the performance Zetes has delivered under the strong leadership of Pierre Lambert.

After more than 20 years as Group CFO and four years as CEO, Pierre Lambert has decided to step down from his role as CEO of Zetes and will transition to become the Chairperson of the Zetes Board of Directors, effective June 2026. The next CEO of Zetes, effective 1st April 2026, will be Ronny Depoortere, who joined Zetes in 2002 to create the People ID Division. He was its Senior Vice President for nearly 20 years and then became its President and Board Member in April 2022.
